## Protecting babies and very young children: Improving practice in Somerset with reflective learning

This **online multi-agency forum** will provide an opportunity for practitioners to consider the learning from the SSCP most recent reviews, consider how all partners can work together to build on existing strengths, discuss solutions to barriers to effective working and avoid recurrent themes to improve safeguarding practice for all children in Somerset, but particularly babies and very young children.

The interactive workshop will look at key components of multi-agency working and how to ensure families with babies and young children receive the right level of support. We will reflect on what families have said about how to improve the services we offer, with a **facilitated discussion** at the end of the session.

The learning will focus on improving outcomes for babies and very young children. However, you will have the opportunity to hear messages from families that are applicable to all age ranges, and would encourage you to attend, whatever age of children you work with.
