

Bronze Silver Gold



Bronze QI training for GP Nurses

"Engaging session with group work. Pleased that QI is now being aimed at Practice Nurses with the training session empowering Nurses to make changes"

- Four hours of training on managing Quality Improvement projects and acting as change agents.
- Small Groups 4-12 Nurses
- 11 Sessions across the county
- 93 GP Nurses Trained
- Average feedback score 4.5 out of 5
- Bronze training provides the foundations for a QI approach – embedding Nurses as leaders of change using the Model for Improvement, day to day
- 18 of 96 attendees of the last (19/20) Somerset wide Primary Care QI Planning event were GP Nurses. The previous year the event had only one regular GP Nurse attendee.

Silver QI training for improvement project teams

- Three half day sessions, with dedicated QI coaching support during life of project.
- First cohort completed: Six Project teams supported that include a total of Ten Primary Care/PCN Nurses.
- GPN 10 focused Silver QI training embedded GP Nurses in major change projects across Somerset

QI and Leadership Coaching

- Ten Primary Care/PCN Nurses received QI coaching as part of improvement teams.
- Six Primary Care Nurses received 1:1 Coaching in applying QI to leading changes in their GP practices.
- Improvement Projects included: Clinical Leadership, Clinical Supervision, Palliative Care, End of Life, MDTs integrated care / DES in care homes, Team Resilience and Clinical Audit.

The future after the GPN10 Programme

- Training Hub support including safe house and Lead Nursing Meeting ongoing
- New Virtual Bronze and Silver QI training offers will be offered to GP Nurses
- QI and leadership Coaching will be expanded with the development of the coaching skills at a PCN level
- New PCN Lead Nurse role in Somerset, will have 12 GP Nurses leaders across the counties as part of PCN/neighbourhood leadership teams.
- Development of Gold QI training for GP Nurse leaders.
