Population health looks at health outcomes of the local population. By understanding where the need is, we can provide care to address the local needs. In partnership with Somerset's public health team Somerset Training Hub is pleased to announce we are now open to expressions of interest for our population health fellowship. The fellowship is open to *anyone* working in primary care. We believe that the success of previous fellowships is because they allow you to be creative pursuing a project which matters to you and your community, while also working with your supervisor to guide you through the year. It supports your development in leading, organising, educating and connecting up with other people in our health/social care system. The fellowship is for 1 day per week for 1 year. Previous fellowships have included:

- a simple technique of reducing harm from overprescribing
- supporting children/families affected by adverse childhood events.
