

Evidence and Library Support – Focus on Nursing

Don't forget the library service is here to help support all staff in the General Practice and Primary and Integrated Care family, including new nurses on the Fellowship or Preceptorship Programme. Just about all of our online resources can be accessed via a laptop, desktop, tablet, or Smartphone. Recent additions include the "Wiley Royal Marsden Manual of Clinical and Nursing Procedures" (latest edition); several titles in the Oxford Nursing Handbook series.

The Oxford titles include: Women's Health Nursing, Gastrointestinal, Respiratory, Cardiac, and Primary Care and Community Nursing. There are also several primary care titles available via the Kortext eBooks collection, including "General Practice at a Glance", "Nursing in General Practice", and "Essential Knowledge and Skills for Healthcare Assistants and Assistant Practitioners". You can also search for items via the new KnowledgeHub at <https://library.nhs.uk/knowledgehub/>, or find out what books we hold in the libraries at both Taunton and Yeovil at <https://swims.inforlib.uk/iguana/www.main.cls?url=HEE>. Don't worry if you can't get into the library, we can send items out by post (unless they're unreasonably heavy!). We can also help you with evidence searches – although if it's for an assignment we may offer an assisted search or refer you to your university subject librarian.
